### ***From the Workbench:***

Degreaser  
Paint Thinner  
Stain

Sealant  
Wood Stripper

Oil-Based Paint  
Solvents  
Rust/Wood Preservatives

### ***From the Garage:***

Antifreeze  
Gasoline

Brake Fluid  
Engine Degreaser

Carburetor Cleaner  
Kerosene

**Small amounts of Latex paint may be dried until solid and thrown away in the regular garbage. Alkaline batteries no longer contain mercury and therefore should be thrown away in the trash.**

***EXCLUDED ITEMS: NO MEDICAL AND INFECTIOUS WASTE, AMMUNITION OR EXPLOSIVES, RADIOACTIVE WASTES INCLUDING SMOKE DETECTORS, EMPTY CONTAINERS AND WASTES FROM NON-HOUSEHOLD SOURCES SUCH AS BUSINESSES, SCHOOLS, FARMS, CHURCHES, ETC.***
